3. Approximate budget for football at every high school in your district and/or jurisdiction (2008-09 if possible).
4. If available, athletic travel budget in regards to football (2008-09 if possible).
5. Approximate budget for maintaining the football stadium, including construction of new stadiums and facilities. (2008-09 if possible)
6. Average Daily Enrollment for each high school (Grades 9-12) in your district and/or jurisdiction."
