
AFFIDAVIT OF DEBRA ACEVES

BEFORE ME, the undersigned Notary Public, this day personally appeared Debra Aceves, who being by me duly sworn on her oath, deposed and stated the following:

1. My name is Debra Aceves. I am over 18 years of age, I am of sound mind, and I understand the taking of an oath. I have personal knowledge of every statement made in this affidavit, all of which are true and correct.
2. I am the Principal of Hudson Bend Middle School ("HBMS") in the Lake Travis Independent School District ("LTISD" "Lake Travis ISD" or "District").
3. I began my career in education in 1993 as a paraprofessional at a private school in El Paso, Texas. I then received a Bachelor's degree and my teaching certification, and taught in public elementary schools in Ysleta Independent School District and Austin Independent School District ("Austin ISD") for five years. During the 2002-2003 school year, I served as a Principal Intern in AISD and became an assistant principal at an elementary school in 2003. Since then, I have worked as a high school assistant principal in AISD and Lake Travis ISD. I became the Principal of HBMS in 2008.
4. I hold the following certifications: Principal All Levels; Bilingual/ESL--Spanish Grades 1-8; Elementary Self-Contained Grades 1-8; Elementary Bilingual/ESL Grades 1-8.
5. Like the other campuses in the District, HBMS uses the V-Soft Raptor System, provided by Raptor Technologies, Inc. ("Raptor System"), to screen visitors to the campus. The Raptor System was first used at HBMS during the 2006-2007 school year, and has been used since then.
6. The Raptor System is used during school hours, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. When the campus hosts an event in which we expect a large volume of parent visitors, we do not use the Raptor System, because we simply would not be able to get parents in the doors fast enough. There was only 1 event during the 2008-2009 school year when we did not use the Raptor system during the school hours indicated, the End of Year Awards on the last day of school, June 4, 2009. On June 4, 2009, visitors were permitted to go into only the gym or the cafeteria, and were not permitted to be in the hallways or classrooms.
7. During the 2008-2009 school year, a sticker stating, "All visitors and guests are required to register at the school office," was located on the windows of the front doors of HBMS during the 2008-2009 school year, as was a sign stating that all visitors must present valid identification when checking in at the front office.
8. When I notice that a non-employee adult in the HBMS building during the school day is not wearing a name tag, I approach them, ask them why they are not

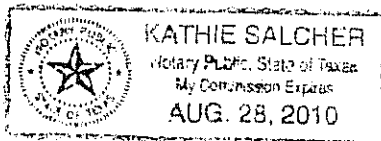
wearing a name tag, and direct them to the office to sign in and obtain a name tag. If the person tells me that they had a name tag, but that it has fallen off, I direct them to the office to get another name tag.


- 9. On April 3, 2009, David Lovelace came to HBMS to attend an event in one of his son's classes. On that day, the class was presenting math games that they had created, and had invited parents. While he was in the front office, Mr. Lovelace did not provide his driver's license to Ms. Margarita Plymire, the HBMS Receptionist. Ms. Plymire entered Mr. Lovelace's name into the Raptor System, and the system printed a sticker name tag for Mr. Lovelace. Because Mr. Lovelace's driver's license had been scanned into the Raptor System before, the information was stored, so the name tag generated by the system contained a scanned version of his driver's license photo and his name.
- 10. For parents whose driver's licenses have already been scanned into the Raptor System, I do not require that their licenses be scanned again, because their information is stored in the system. Instead, the parent's name is manually typed into the Raptor System, and the system generates a sticker name tag that displays the person's name and photograph. The parent is required to wear the name tag while on campus.
