Mr. Lovelace,

The Lake Travis Independent School District (“LTISD” or “District”) has become aware of your website, located at www.ltidschools.info.¹ On your website, you use the LTISD logo. The LTISD logo that you use (similar to that used in this letterhead), has been copyrighted and LTISD owns that copyright.

As you may know, federal statute stipulates that a copyright owner has the exclusive right to use and reproduce the copyrighted item. *See* 17 U.S.C. §106. A party who uses or reproduces the copyrighted item without the owner’s permission commits infringement of the copyright in violation of the law. *See* 17 U.S.C. §501, *et. seq.*

LTISD has not provided you permission to use its logo, and therefore you are infringing on the copyright. I am requesting, on behalf of the District, that you cease using the copyrighted LTISD logo on your website. The District would appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
