Re: Response USB Key Loss

Dear Ms. Greenberg:

I am in receipt of your December 22, 2005 letter in which you state that the missing USB memory key has been found and that the matter is closed. The matter is not closed since you have failed to answer the questions I have directed to you regarding the missing device. It would be remiss to deny a response in context to each of my questions and concerns since you proffered the opportunity to correspond regarding this matter. Is it your standard practice to make such requests then to unilaterally withdraw them?

Again, I remind you that your letter of December 20, 2005 states: "*Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or concerns regarding this matter*". My questions and concerns communicated to you in my December 21, 2005 letter have yet to be answered. For your benefit, I am including the original questions from my December 21, 2005 response:

1. Has any confidential information regarding our son Matthew been jeopardized by this loss?
2. Has any of [REDACTED] confidential information covered by FERPA or HIPPA been compromised at any time by the Lake Travis ISD?
3. Is it the practice of the Lake Travis ISD to expose confidential information?
4. Who, specifically the name and position of the Lake Travis ISD records custodian, is responsible for the loss of this confidential information?

Your timely response within the context of each of my questions and concerns would only be appropriate since you requested them.
